## MINI-GUITARS



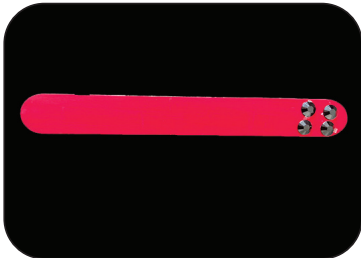
### YOU WILL NEED:

- jar lids
- jumbo wooden craft sticks
- acrylic paint and a paintbrush
- rhinestone stickers
- colorful rubber bands
- tape (packing or duct)
- non-toxic white glue (safe for both you and the environment)
- laser tape (optional: if you want to make your guitar really shiny)
- scissors



### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Take a craft stick, your favorite color of paint and a paintbrush. Paint the craft stick and let dry completely.



2. Once the craft stick is dry, take four rhinestone stickers and place on one end of the stick.

**BONUS:** If you want your guitar to have a little more personality, you can take some sparkly laser tape, cut some pieces, and press them on.



3. Take a lid and 3 or 4 rubber bands and wrap the bands around the lid. Turn the lid around and tape the rubber bands so they stay in place when you're making your rocking music.



4. Grab your glue and paste the other end of your craft stick to the lid—you can use tape but the glue helps keep it in place.



5. Now it's time to strum your mini-guitar and make some music!
