
Princess Elizabeth needs to find her way through the maze to get to her castle. Can you help her?




- 5. Turn over so you can see the pictures
- 6. Slide your thumb and your finger behind they bend around and touch two of the pictures and press together so
- 7. Turn over and repeat with the thumb and finger of the other hand for the other two pictures.
- 8. All of the pictures should now be facing up and touching at the center. You are ready to use your fortune teller!



- 1. Choose a word (princess, dragon, tennis, or crown).
- 2. Spell out the word and with each letter, open the fortune teller in one direction and then the other.
- 3. Once the word is spelled out, choose one of the numbers showing.
- 4. Open the fortune teller in one direction and then the other for each number count
- 5. Repeat one more time.
- 6. Choose a number and lift the flap to see your fortune!




